BOAT STORAGE RENTAL REGULATIONS

- Payments for renewals must be postmarked by March 31 and returned to the address above. No renewals will be accepted after this date.
- Boat racks/storage spaces are rented from the Recreation Department annually and are valid **May 1st** **through November 1st**.
- **All boats MUST be removed by November 1 or be subject to property seizure.**
- Boats not removed by November 1 will be seized and future rental will be denied. Property will be released to owner upon receipt of payment of seizure fee. The boat owner will be notified of this action.
Seizure Fees: Day sailors: \$140 Catamarans: \$220 Boats on racks: \$90 each.
- No additions to the racks may be made with the exception of a keel roller, which should be removed at the end of each rental season.
- All boats must display a town boat number on the stern of the vessel. Number issued by the Beach & Recreation Department. Failure to display this number shall result in the cancellation of the rental agreement and your vessel will be removed, at your expense, from the premises.
- All boats stored at Madison Town beaches, including those used for ingress and egress to boats moored in open waters, must be kept in assigned storage space.
- Boat storage rental spaces are nonrefundable and are nontransferable.
- No boats or powerboats will be allowed to land, pickup or discharge passengers in the designated swim areas.
- For safety reasons, sailboats must lower their sails when on the beach.
- The Beach & Recreation Director or Police Officer may confiscate any boat being moored or stored in violation of any of the rules and regulations, and may cause the same to be taken to and stored in a suitable place at the boat owner's expense. The boat owner will be notified of this action.
- It is highly recommended that you lock your boats to your assigned rack.
- Neither the Beach & Recreation Department nor the Town of Madison is liable for vandalism or damage done to your boat while it is stored on Town property. Please file a report with the Madison Police Department should vandalism or theft occur.
