HAZARDOUS WASTE – GET RID OF IT SAFELY!

Responsible disposal of hazardous household waste doesn't come cheap. Fortunately residents of Madison have already paid the bill to dispose of the hazardous waste in their homes. Please remember that this service is seasonal and hazardous waste removal at other times of year is quite expensive, so we urge residents to act seasonally.

Each year the Town of Madison participates in HOUSEHOLD HAZWASTE CENTRAL located at the Regional Water Authority in New Haven. Residents of participating towns are invited to bring most hazardous wastes to the site at 90 Sargent Drive (Long Wharf exit) on Saturday mornings between 9AM and Noon. 2010 Collections begin on May 15th and continue to October 30th.

No collections will be made on major holiday weekends (Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day). Additionally Madison hosts a satellite collection at Hammonasset State Park from 9:00 a.m. to Noon on either the last Saturday of September or the first Saturday in October. The 2010 satellite date is September 25th.
