**Emergency Meeting in Response to Hurricane Irene  
Minutes**

First Selectman McPherson called the Emergency Meeting in Response to Hurricane Irene of Monday, August 29, 2011 to order at 4:30 p.m.

**DISCUSSION:** First Selectman McPherson announced that Representative Joe Courtney and Lieutenant Governor Nancy Wyman would be coming to Madison the next morning to survey the damage.

First Selectman McPherson commented the meeting was being called with key Town staff members, members of the Board of Selectmen, and volunteers to receive a series of updates from Town staff concerning the emergency situation as Madison recovers from the effects of Hurricane Irene. A general discussion ensued from the various Town departments concerning issues such as water delivery to the citizenry, the status of roads, and the reinstatement of electrical service. There was a general discussion about the effectiveness of the Town's citizen communication efforts which include robo calls, emails, and flyers. A new information line was established where citizens could call should they miss the automated robo call.

**Adjournment:** There being no objections, at 5:10 p.m. First Selectman McPherson adjourned the Emergency Meeting in Response to Hurricane Irene. The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday morning, August 30, 2011 at 8:00 a.m.
