NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Madison will conduct a public hearing by the Town Council on the **23rd day of March, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Campus Room A**, located at 8 Campus Drive, Madison, CT to discuss its 2018 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant.

The purpose of the public hearing is to provide information and obtain citizen's views on the progress of the Grant under the Public Housing Modernization category for the Concord Meadows Senior Housing Energy and ADA Improvements which was funded under the Connecticut Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program which is a federally funded program designed to assist governments with activities directed toward neighborhood and housing revitalization, economic development, and improved community facilities and services.
