1. Call to Order. The meeting was called to order at 5:12 p.m. by Chairman Weiss.

2. Sustainable Connecticut. Woodie said he and Tracy are trying to get Portfolio Manager System up to date by filling in data and track energy consumption and compare with 2017. Woodie mentioned that it looks like we are in excess of 15%, not including PVs, in electric.

Woodie asked Guy to put a spreadsheet together as to possible locations for EV infrastructures.

3. DHHS demand discussion – carport PV? Woodie said that he, Tom Litor, and Bill McMinn are looking to cut peak demand, and considering a carport with five powerpacks and one inverter at this point. Woodie said that a 400kw ZREC would only get one third the way.

4. Offshore Wind Project. Francis said he attended a gathering of state and local leaders a couple weeks ago in New London where 200 megawatts of offshore wind project was awarded to developer, Deepwater Wind, that includes a 25-turbine wind farm in federal waters south of Martha's Vineyard. The company plans to start construction in 2021 and deliver power by 2023

5. VW Settlement Woodie said that he participated in an online webinar today and that Madison's trucks do not qualify for this because they don't drive enough or idle enough
