

ANNUAL BUDGET RECONCILIATION TOWN MEETING
June 26, 2018

The Annual Budget Reconciliation Town Meeting of the Town of Madison was held on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at the Town Campus, Room A.

In attendance were the entire Board of Selectmen (Thomas Banisch, Jean W. Ferris, Al Goldberg, Scott M. Murphy, Bruce H. Wilson, Jr.), and myself (Nancy J. Martucci). Eleven (11) residents were present along with three (3) Town employees and one (1) non-resident reporter from Shore Publishing.

At 6:34 p.m. due to a lack of a quorum all appropriations passed according to Section 2.1.1 of the Madison Town Charter. First Selectmen Banisch read the five (5) appropriations and offered to answer any questions.

1. E.C. Scranton Memorial Library in the amount of \$600,000 for the Town's share of pre-construction costs.
2. Public Works Department in the amount of \$49,500 for snow removal services for the 2017-2018 season.
3. Police Department in the amount of \$60,000 for OT Replacement.
4. HR in the amount of \$75,000 for a Heart and Hypertension claim for Dobbins.
5. Board of Education in the amount of \$120,000 to fund the Effective School Solutions program in Fiscal Year 2018-2019; pending approval at the June 16, 2018 Regular Meeting of the Board of Selectmen at 7:00 p.m.
