The Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (Authority) acknowledges receipt of the April 2, 2019 motion (Motion No. 64) filed on behalf of the Town of Madison (Town), requesting clarification concerning the applicability of the Authority's ruling on Motion No. 50 (Bloom Ruling) in the above docket, to the Authority's ruling denying the Town's Motion No. 126 in Docket No. 11-12-06, Joint Petition by The Connecticut Light and Power Company and The United Illuminating Company for Approval of the Solicitation Plan for the Low and Zero Emissions Renewable Energy Credit Program. Essentially, the Town is seeking approval to be eligible to submit subsequent ZREC bids in later rounds.

The Authority also acknowledges receipt of the April 10, 2019 Objection to Motion No. 64 (Objection) filed on behalf of The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy (CL&P).

The Authority hereby approves the Town's request, as the Town's new proposal for ground-mounted panels is fundamentally different from the original rooftop proposal.
